

Gift Pouch



Items needed (quantity per creation)

- A4 craft felt
- Hole punch
- Pencil
- Plate (or similar round object)
- 60cm cord or string
- Scissors

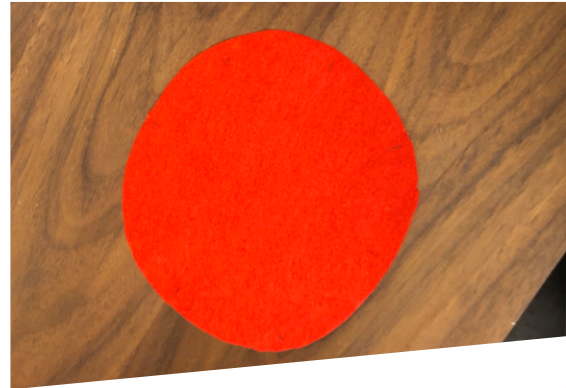
Optional

- Embellishments

Instructions

1. Draw a circle onto your felt by placing a plate on it and drawing around. Cut out your circle.
2. Make a mark at the top of the circle, then the bottom of the circle. Now make a mark on the left hand side and then the right. Add one more mark between each of these making eight marks total.
3. Use the punch to cut a hole at each of the marks.

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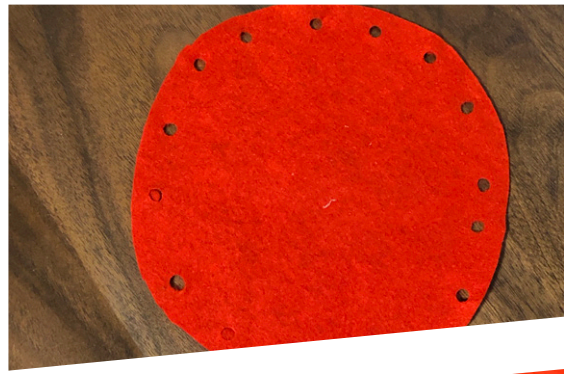

4. Now use the hole punch again to make another hole between each of the existing holes. This will give you 16 holes. If you wish to embellish the outside this is the point to do it.
5. With the good face of your felt facing down, take your cord and thread it up through the first hole. It is important to go up to start as this leaves the string on the outside to tie.
6. Go down through the next hole, then up and so on until all the holes are threaded. Place your gift in the centre of your pouch.
7. Gently pull the two ends of the cord, this will start to gather the felt around the item. Pull until shut.
8. Tie a knot with the cord and then a bow. If you have leftover cord you can continue to make bows until it's all used up.



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
