Hanging Trees

Items needed (quantity per creation)

- Copy paper
- Pencil
- 2cm square piece of coloured card
- Paper straw (plastic will also work)
- String
- Needle
- 1 x 5mm wooden bead (plastic beads will work too)

Instructions

- 1. Cut a 10cm circle out of copy paper. As the layers get small this might get hard for younger children, in which case you can start larger.
- 2. Fold your circle into quarters.
- 3. Then in half, this is the template to make the snowflake shapes.

Hanging Trees cont.

- 4. Along the edge that doesn't have a fold cut out a pattern. Cut 1 mm off the top point.
- 5. Unfold the pattern to show your snowflake design. Repeat steps 1 4 making each circle smaller. For this example five were done.
- 6. Take your string and tie the bead onto one end.
- 7. Cut your straw into pieces. You need as many pieces as you have snowflakes
- 8. Thread on one straw piece.

Hanging Trees cont.

- 9. Then add the biggest snowflake layer.
- 10. Repeat steps 8 and 9 until all are on the string.
- 11. Cut a small star from the coloured card and using a needle make two small holes.
- 12. Thread the star onto the string, this should hold it all in place. Tie a loop in the other end of your string for hanging.
