

Tree Garland



Items needed (quantity per creation)

- 1 square green card (cut down an a4 sheet) per tree
- 1 paperclip per tree
- String
- Hot glue/PVA
- Scissors

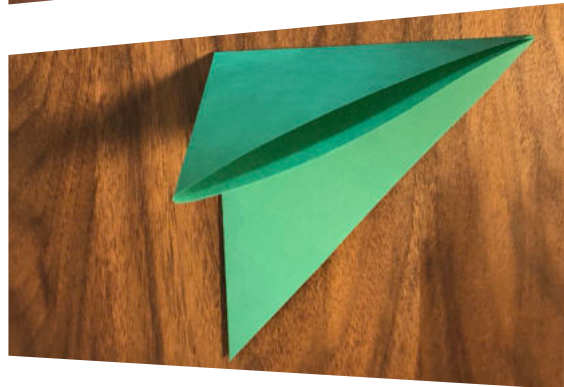
Instructions

This craft uses an origami tree to make a garland, the length is up to you. If the origami gets a bit hard to follow you can look up a video tutorial on youtube [youtube.com/watch?v=KG9vggBcQPw](https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=KG9vggBcQPw)

1. Take your paper and fold in half diagonally from corner to corner.
2. Now take fold again halving the long edge.
3. Unfold and fold the square in half as shown in the photo



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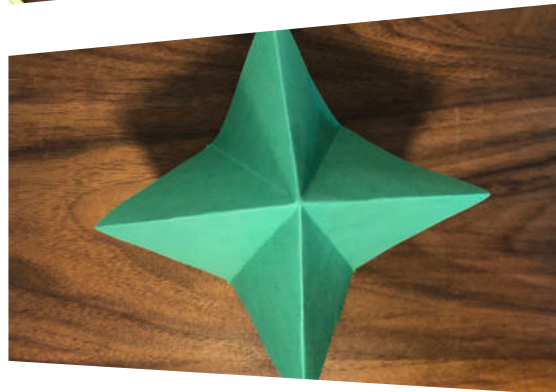
Tree Garland cont.

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4. Fold in half again side to side.
5. Unfold your card, fold in half corner to corner. Holding the two corners of the folded edge fold them towards each other to create a diamond shape with four sides that stick out.
6. On each of these sides fold the folded edge towards the middle.
7. Gently open each of these fold and fold them inside as shown leaving you with 8 sides.
8. Your folded piece should now look like this
9. Cut off the bottom flap to create the tree shape

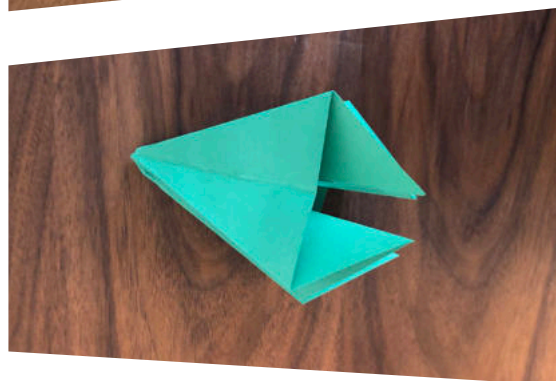


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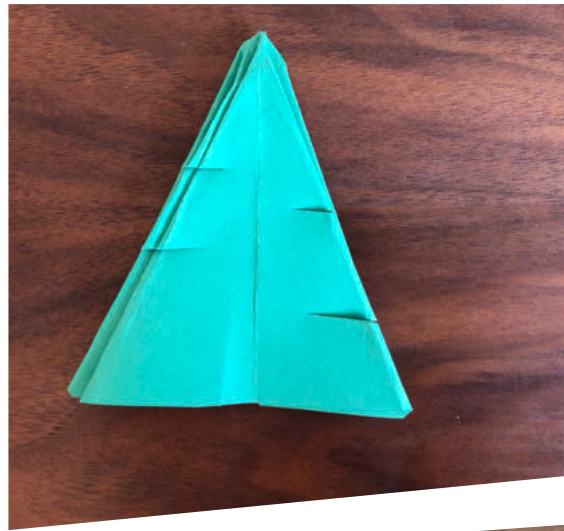


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Tree Garland cont.

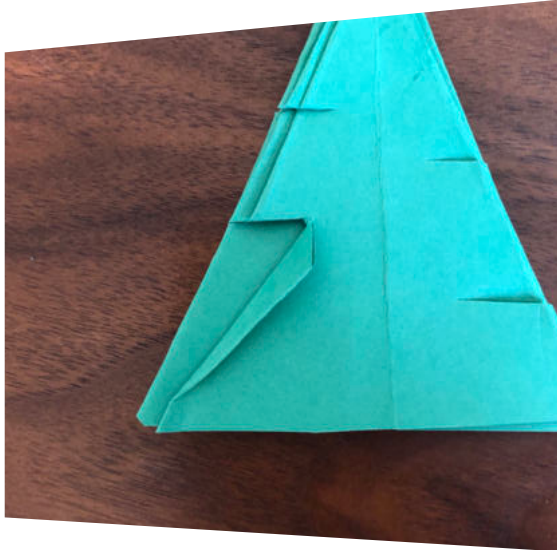
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10. On each of the folded edges cut two or three lines.



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11. Then fold over each of these as shown in the photo.

12. Your tree should now look like this.



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13. Cut a very small piece off the top of the tree and glue in your paper clip, this will become the loop for the string. Repeat steps 1-13 until you have the amount of trees you want.

14. Take your string and thread it through the loop in the top of a tree, tie a small knot to hold it in place. Continue until
